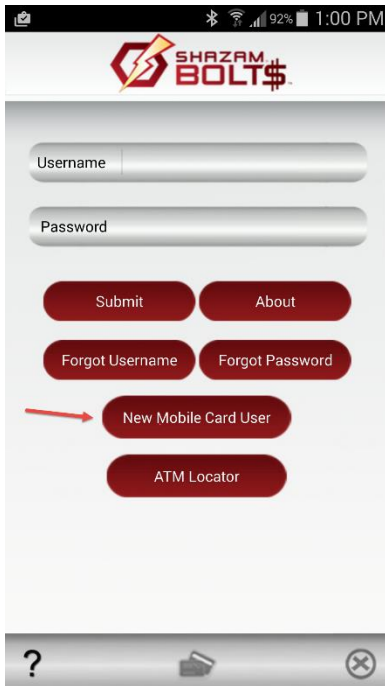


Bank of McCrory Shazam Bolt\$ Instructions

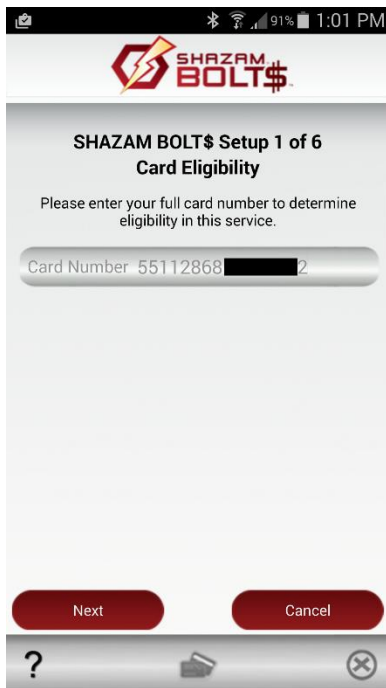
The free BOLT\$ apps can be found in either Apple App Store for iPhones or Google Play for Androids. Search for “ShazamBolt\$”. (I’m using Google Play for an Android.) You can also setup Bolt\$ from a browser on a PC at <https://bolts.shazam.net/ShazamWebPortal/index.php>.

Once you have installed the app, open the app and the below screen should appear. Click the “New Mobile Card User” button. (You will need your debit card, and prepare to have a unique username and password.)

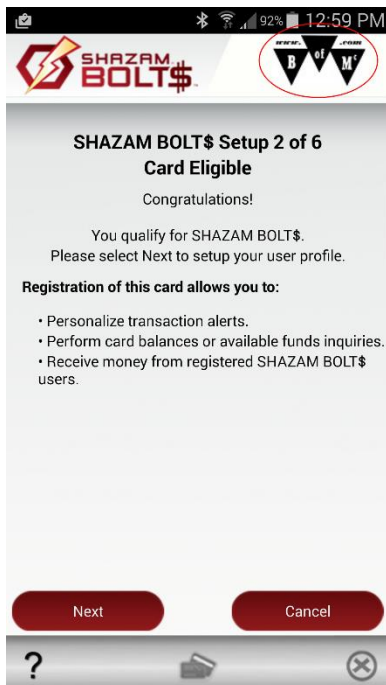


This will bring you to the below screen. Input your full card number (it will start with “55112868”). Hit the “Next” button.

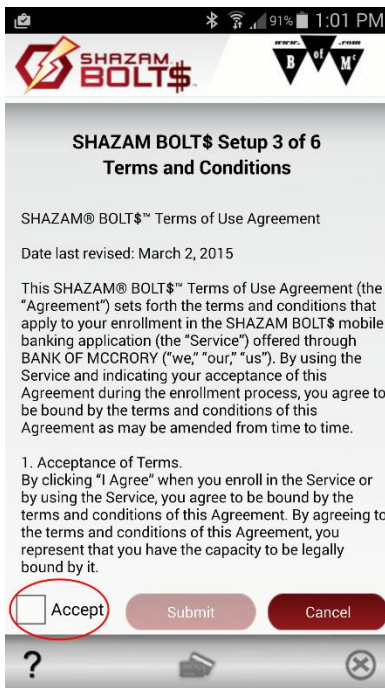


You should see the below screen. Notice the Bank of McCrory logo in the top right hand corner. Hit the "Next" button.

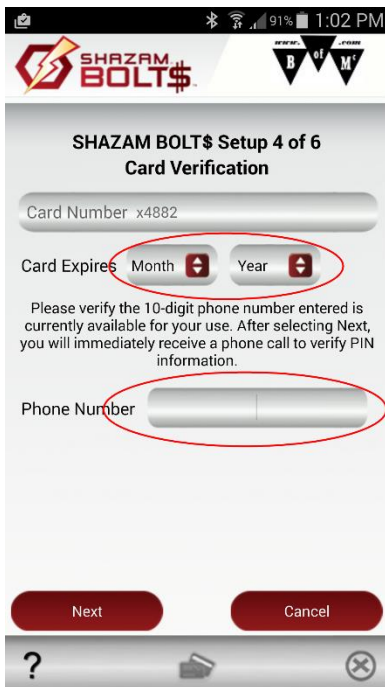


The below screen is where you accept the Terms and Conditions for Shazam Bolt\$ use. Click the "Accept" box and click the "Submit" button.


Screen “4 of 6” is where you start setting up your account with Shazam Bolt\$. Click the drop down to enter the month and year of the card’s expiration date. Next input your mobile phone number. When you hit the “Next” button, you should immediately receive a confirmation phone call from Shazam. A recorded voice will ask you for the card’s PIN number. It is safe to input your card’s PIN. (This is part of the confirmation process.)

The “User Profile” screen is the only screen I had trouble with. The “Username” and “Password” fields are very finicky. The username must be unique to Shazam, so it cannot be “Mike” or “John”. I finally used one of my names with some numbers behind it.


The password requires upper case, lower case, number, and special character. (I used the “@” symbol for my special character. It wouldn’t accept a period or equal mark.) After several tries I hit the “Next” button.

It asks you for your mailing address and a primary and secondary email address. (The secondary email address is not required, but recommended if you have one.)

Make sure the domain "shazambolts.net" is white listed in your email spam filter. Shazam Bolt\$ will send you a confirmation email to make sure the email address you supplied works properly. (It took about 10 minutes before I received my email.) Once you receive the email and click the "Activation Link" hyperlink in the email, you should be good to go. Once you login to your account you can see the (Shazam) balance on your card, change your profile settings, change your password... even add another card number. Notices should come to the phone number you listed (first) or your primary email account (second).
